

In order to participate in the June 9 ceremony, all required credits must be posted to a student's transcript by 4:00 PM on June 1st.

Shelby Steward (pictured on the right) is our Teacher of the Year. Ms. Steward teaches World Geography and AP Human Geography.


HISD Educators of the Year from schools all around the district were honored at a special banquet last Friday night at the Hilton Americas Hotel.
