A limited number of non-Westside guest tickets will be sold and a printed copy of the guest's current ID will be required at the time of purchase. Please read all of the details on the contracts very carefully. Advance ticket purchase is required. Absolutely no tickets will be sold at the door.

The Dance will be held on Saturday, October 28th in the Commons from 8-11:30 PM. Students are encouraged to grab a friend, or get a group together, and come out to enjoy this fun Westside tradition! They do not need to have a date and they do not need to be dressed for the Red Carpet (see dress guidelines on the contracts).
