## Westside Hosts Visitors from China



On the Friday before Thanksgiving break, Westside hosted a delegation of educators from the Haidian district of Beijing, China. The twenty-five teachers and their guides spent the day at Westside as part of a 28-day United States travel itinerary, including Houston, Austin, and Washington D.C. During their trip they will tour American schools, museums, and other educational attractions and venues.

Several native Mandarin-speaking Westside students acted as ambassadors for the group. The school tour included a visit to our own outdoor environmental science lab, the Wolf Prairie, guided by Ms. Klein's Ecology

Club students. The guests also rotated through several classroom observations and were treated to a mini Fine Arts showcase, including performances by Choir, Inertia, and a Brass Ensemble.



## Choices Topic: E-Cigarettes

Hello Parents!

Greetings from the Choices Program. As scientific research continues, and data keeps coming in, the picture regarding the impact of e-cigarettes on health and adolescent brain development is becoming clearer. The adolescent brain is much more sensitive to the effects of nicotine than an adult brain. E-cigarettes are not safe and have been found to contain carcinogens<sup>1</sup>. Research has shown that even brief adolescent exposure to nicotine has been proven to enhance the reinforcing value of other abused drugs.

### Did you know?

- E-cig/vaporizer liquid produces cancer-causing chemicals that have been linked to lung disease<sup>1</sup>
- **It is illegal to sell E-cigarettes or related tobacco products to minors in Texas**
- Over 75% of young adults believe that e-cigarettes are harmful to the body<sup>3</sup>
- Teens that use e-cigs/vaporizers are **27x more likely** to smoke marijuana<sup>3</sup>
- 1 in 3 teens are unaware of the nicotine concentration of their e-cigarette<sup>2</sup>
- E-cigarette use is strongly linked to the use of other tobacco products such as regular cigarettes, cigars, hookah, and smokeless tobacco<sup>4</sup>
- In 2014, e-cigarettes surpassed regular cigarettes as the most popular form of nicotine ingestion among middle and high school students
- Nicotine is the most addictive drug known to man
- Epidemiologic studies have shown that nicotine use is a gateway to the use of marijuana and cocaine in human populations<sup>5</sup>
- ***JUUL electronic cigarettes deliver roughly 1.5 times the amount of nicotine than a traditional tobacco cigarette***

Effective August 8, 2016, the US [Food and Drug Administration](#) (FDA) mandates [electronic cigarettes](#) products to be regulated as tobacco products. The FDA rule also bans sales to minors. The FDA classified e-cigarettes as drug delivery devices and subject to regulation under the [Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act](#) (FDCA) before importation and sale in the US.

Nicotine is more harmful to teens than adults because it slows development of the adult brain in adolescents. This can lead to slowed or arrested development of executive functioning skills, especially impulse control. In a study in the Journal of Physiology, researchers found that e-cigarettes have been linked to cognitive deficits in emotional learning and memory in adolescents. The adolescent brain has a distinct neurobiology and unique sensitivity to nicotine. [Click here for full study.](#)

Nicotine exposure during adolescence has been proven to enhance the reinforcing value of other abused drugs. In a sense, the brain is "primed" or sensitized to the pleasurable effects of drugs of abuse. A study in the New England Journal of Medicine shows how nicotine acts as a gateway drug in mice. According to the researchers, "Nicotine acts as a gateway drug on the brain, and this effect is likely to occur whether the exposure is from smoking tobacco, passive tobacco, or e-cigarettes." 
In a 2017 study by chemists at the University of Connecticut, researchers found that electronic cigarettes are potentially as harmful as tobacco cigarettes. The researchers found that vapor from *non-nicotine* e-cigarettes caused as much DNA damage as filtered cigarettes, possibly due to the many

chemical additives present in the vapor. **Cellular mutations caused by DNA damage can lead to cancer.** [Click here to read more about this study.](#)

A 2016 study published in the Journal of Environmental Science & Technology found that the flavoring compounds in e-cigarette liquid produce more carcinogenic toxic aldehydes than the base ingredients of the liquid itself. This is the first study I have seen that shows the flavorings, themselves, are toxic. [Click here for full research study.](#)
