HISD has partnered with Healthy Schools this year to provide free flu vaccines to all students enrolled in school. Healthy Schools is an in-school health service provider that focuses on increasing access to quality, no-cost preventative

healthcare for children. A team of nurses from Healthy Schools will be on the Westside campus on Thursday, November 8th, to administer the flu vaccines.

Students must have advance parental consent to receive the flu vaccine. Consent forms are available in

the clinic or click <u>here</u> to print the consent form at home.

Completed consent forms must be signed by parent/guardian and returned to the Westside clinic by Friday, September 28.

Remember, in addition to washing your hands, the flu vaccine is the primary way to protect against contracting the highly contagious flu virus.

Do You Need Credit Appeal?

If a student receives an "NG" on their report card due to excessive absences, they may be eligible to apply to participate in the Credit Appeal process.

The 18 -19 Credit Appeal Process requires the student and parent to complete ALL steps below without exception:

- The student will obtain a report card from his/her dean or house secretary. This document will indicate which courses are subject to the credit appeal process.
- 2. The student and parent will attend a parent meeting on one of the following Saturdays:

Parent/Student Meetings

Saturday, September 15 9:00 AM or Saturday, September 22, 9:00 am

- Parent meetings are one-on-one, and students will be taken on first come first serve basis starting at 9:00 am.
- Please bring your report card and transcript when you attend the parent meeting.
- The student will be assigned required number of Credit Appeal sessions during the parent meeting

Student Leaving Early?

Students need approval from the Attendance Office to leave school early. For complete details, please click here.

Parent Pick-Up:

- Parent/Guardian must sign-in to receive a visitor pass and then proceed to the Attendance Office
- Parent/Guardian must arrive in the Attendance Office no later than 3:35 PM.
- Please allow ample time for the early dismissal process. The total time it takes to send for students and for them to appear in the Attendance Office varies widely. Plan accordingly.

Students Driving Themselves:

- Student must deliver a note signed by parent/guardian to the Attendance Office before fist period <u>OR</u> Parent must submit a note to the Attendance Office via email or fax including a picture ID
- Note needs to include:
- -name, grade, and ID number of student
- -date, time and reason for early dismissal
- -parent signature and phone number
- The Attendance Office will:
- -call parent for verification
- -provide a pass for student to be dismissed to the Attendance Office at specified time
- -provide a permit for the student to leave campus

What Do I Do If I Lose My Laptop?

Students are expected to keep up with their school-issued laptops at all times. If a laptop is lost, here are the steps to follow:

- 1. Check the Welcome Desk, Main Office and Police Office to see if someone has turned it in.
- If lost on-campus or in an HISD facility/ school bus, go to your House Office and fill out an HISD police report. The report must be signed by your Dean and will be sent to the Tech Room.

 If lost off-campus, go to the Houston Police Department website and file an <u>HPD theft report</u>. Inform the Tech Room and provide the case number.

(*If lost outside the city of Houston, report to local law enforcement in that area)

- 4. Once a report is filed, a 5-day waiting period begins.
- 5. If the laptop does not turn up within 5 days, the student will go to the Tech Room to pay a \$25 fee and a new laptop will be issued.



Take Care of School Fees Online Using School-Pay

For your convenience, Westside offers School Pay: a new way to pay for school services! The district has contracted with School Pay, so you can pay using a credit card.
