Something New—"Parent U"

HISD has introduced a new program this year, "Parent University". Parent U is designed to provide parents with the supports they need to be invested in the success of their children's education. It offers parents an introduction to district programs, community resources, and parent-engagement strategies.

Westside will launch this new initiative with a special presentation especially for our own Freshman parents: Parent U Freshman Focus, Thursday, September 27th, from 6-7:30 PM here at school. Freshman parents will rotate through four sessions:



- Student Support Systemsincluding info on Grade Speed, tutorials, teacher lesson plans and the role of the Dean
- Personal Graduation
 Plans (PGPs)-details on
 mapping an individualized
 4-year plan
- College Planning & Naviance-resources for planning and preparing for college
- Clubs & Sports-advice on the importance of student involvement and feeling "plugged-in"

HISD will host additional Parent University sessions periodically during the year in various locations throughout the district. They will include resource fairs featuring HISD staff and community partners. At the end of the year, parents will receive recognition for successful completion of the program.
