## English

## Math



⇒ **Algebra II (Polley):** Students will add, subtract, and multiply polynomial functions.

⇒ **Geometry:** Students will construct graphs of circles in the coordinate plane.

⇒ **Pre-Calculus (Kim):** Students will find the limit of the polynomials.

⇒ **AP Calculus:** Students will calculate, interpret, and apply integrals.

⇒ **AP Statistics:** Students will develop and begin individualized AP exam review plans.

⇒ **College Algebra:** Students will solve systems of equations using matrices.

## Science



⇒ **Pre-AP Chemistry:** Students will review gas laws.

⇒ **AP Biology:** Students will start review for the AP exam.

⇒ **AP Physics:** Students will study electric forces.

## Social Studies



⇒ **AP Human Geography:** Students will evaluate the infrastructure of cities.

⇒ **AP World History:** Students will be looking at the great wars this week (WWI/Interwar Years/WWII).

⇒ **US History (Morton):** Students are reading and responding to historical era written works and primary sources.

⇒ **Government and Economics (Morton):** In government, students are looking at case studies and relating them to civil liberties. In economics, students are focusing upon the use of math in economics.
