⇒ **English III (Morton):** Students are presenting their research project focused upon the U.S. prison system and will continue reading *A Lesson Before Dying*.


⇒ **English IV (Morton):** Students are presenting their research project, focused upon ethics in science, and will continue reading *Frankenstein*.

⇒ **Algebra I:** Students have completed their STAAR exam and will begin reviewing for their final exam.

⇒ **Algebra II (Baker):** Students will finish teaching their lessons and begin preparation for their final exam.

⇒ **Algebra II (Polley):** Students will review absolute value equations and inequalities to prepare for the final exam.

⇒ **Geometry:** Students will calculate the measures of arcs and angles formed by intersecting arcs.

⇒ **Pre-Calculus (Baker):** Students will finish teaching their lessons and begin preparation for their final exam.

⇒ **Pre-Calculus (Kim):** Students will review for the final exam.

⇒ **AP Calculus:** Students will review for the final exam.

⇒ **AP Statistics:** Students will review linear regression and correlation in preparation for the AP exam and the final exam.

Science



⇒ **Pre-AP Chemistry:** Students will review acids, bases, and pH.

⇒ **AP Biology:** Students will take the AP Biology exam on May 14 and the HAIS final exam on May 17.

⇒ **AP Physics:** Students will review for the final exam.

⇒ **AP Human Geography:** Students will review for the AP exam and ace it on Friday!

⇒ **US History (Morton):** Students are reading and responding to primary resources and then to the book, *Lies My Teacher Told Me*.

⇒ **Government and Economics (Morton):** Students are preparing for their final and completing all make-up work.
