LEE HIGH SCHOOL

OVERVIEW

Lee High School was originally built in 1962 on Houston's west side. Through its college preparatory curriculum and hands-on field experiences, Lee offers students programs in Business Management and Administration, Health Sciences, Human Services, Information Technology, Law, Public Safety, and more.


Under the HISD bond program, Lee is being rebuilt to accommodate 1,700 to 1,900 students. The 240,000-squarefoot facility will feature a two-story building divided into four neighborhood wings with open spaces and plenty of windows to maximize natural light. The main entrance to the school will remain on the north, allowing the campus to keep its historic Beverly Hill street address.

Construction on the new building is expected to be complete in the second quarter of 2017. Once the new building is complete and students have moved in, the original building will be demolished, making room for athletics fields and additional parking.
