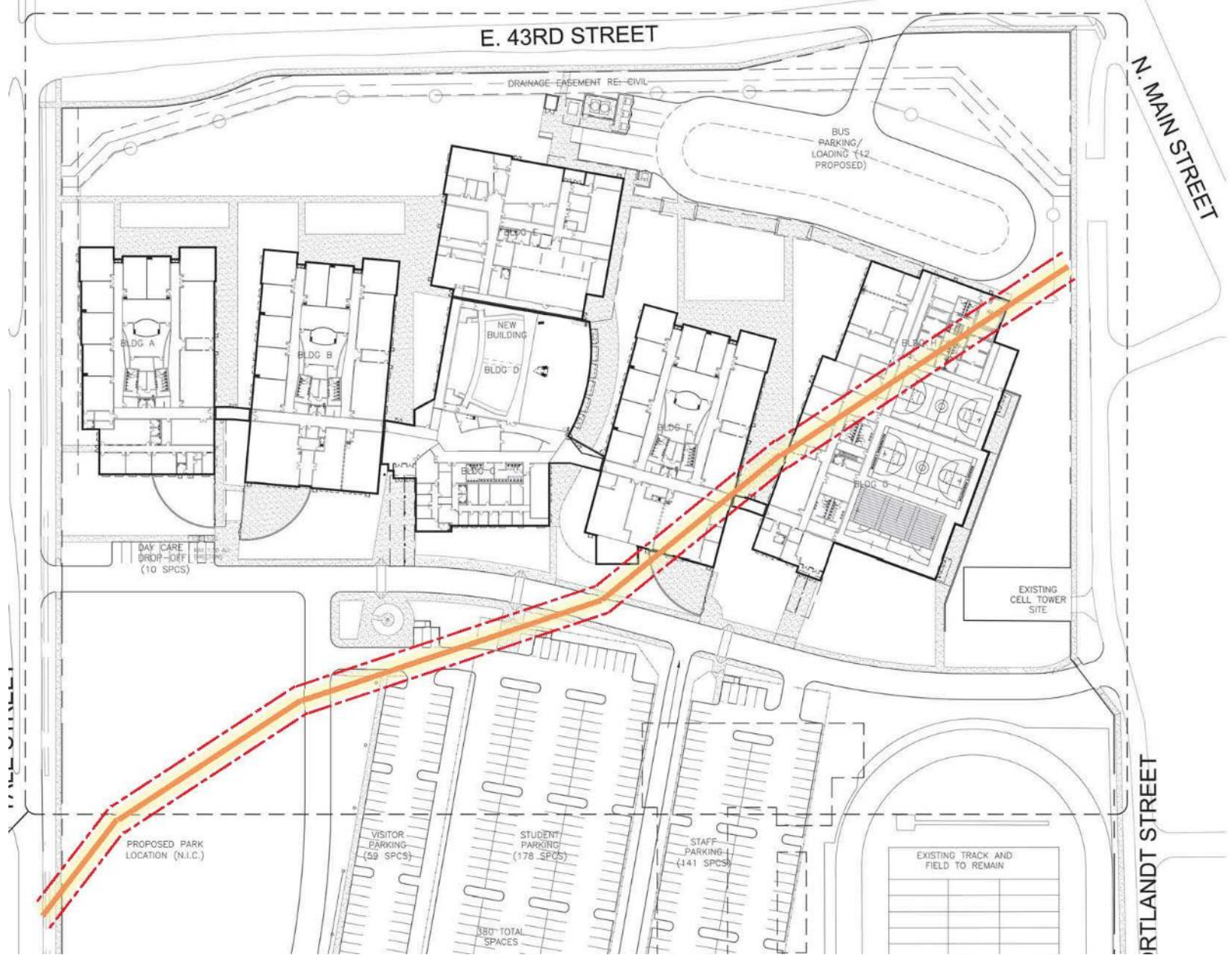

Neighborhood



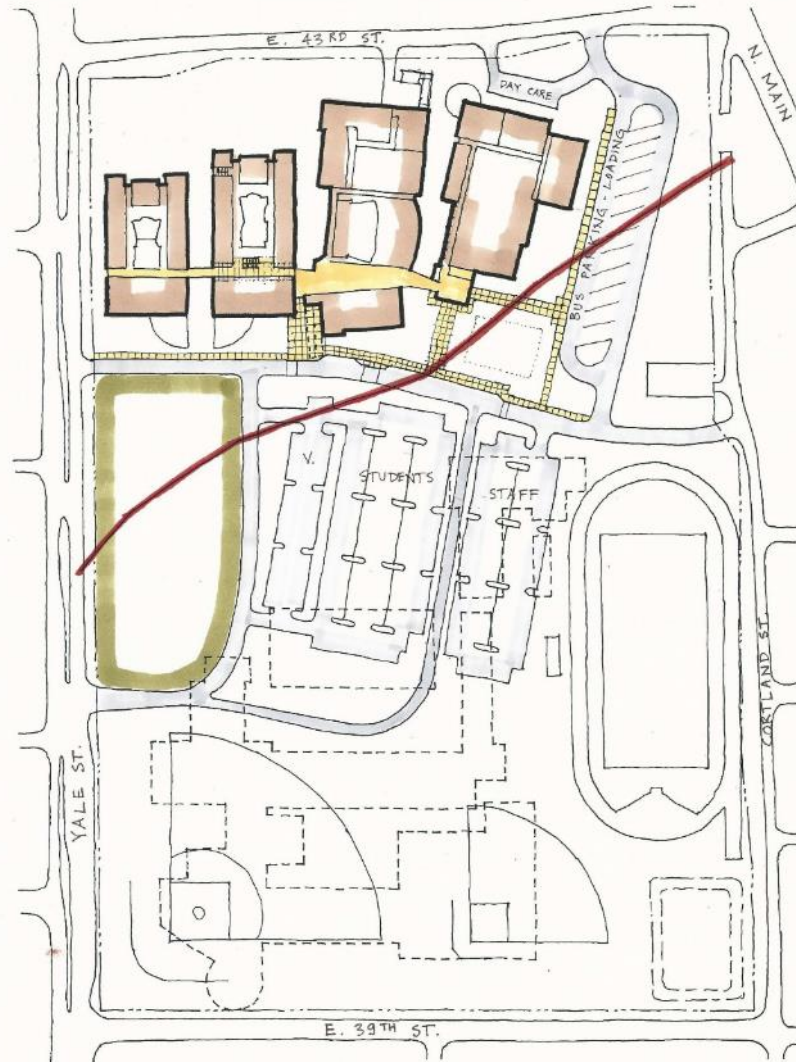

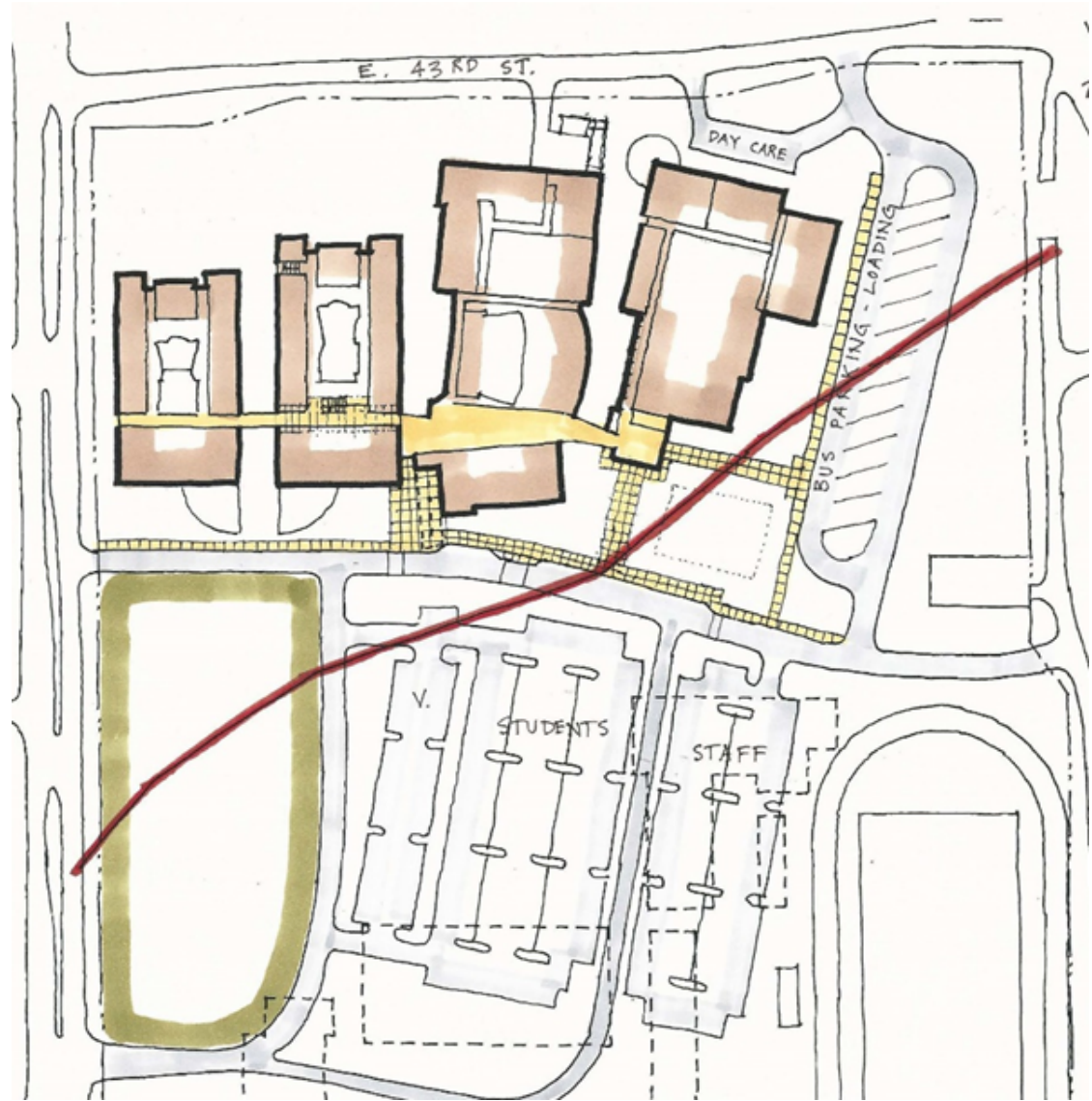

## Solution Advantages

- All buildings are north of the fault line.
- Utilizes existing design components.
- Allows completion of the new buildings prior to demolishing of the existing school.
- Least disruptive to existing school schedule and activities.
- Current track and football field may be retained, as proposed in current documents.
