## How do we develop SOCIAL skills within an IB curriculum?

Caring for the whole child, we develop our students' **SOCIAL** skills by providing authentic and explicit opportunities to develop **interpersonal relationships**, as well as, **social and emotional intelligence**.

Here are some examples of how we develop interpersonal relationships:

- Practicing empathy and care for others
- Listen closely to others' perspectives and to instruction
- Being respectful of others
- Learning cooperatively in a group: being courteous, sharing, taking turns
- Helping others to succeed
- Building consensus and negotiating effectively
- Making fair and equitable decisions
- Encouraging others to contribute
- Taking on a variety of roles in group learning
- Advocating for one's own rights and needs, and those of others.

## Here are examples of how we develop **social and emotional intelligence**:

- Creating awareness of our own and others' emotions
- Managing anger and resolve conflict
- Becoming self and socially aware
- Becoming aware of our and others' impact as members of a learning group
