SPARK Update

- Original date for dedication was April 8. Has been postponed to April 22 due to concrete pour.
- Approximately 30-minute ceremony. Will have snacks afterward.
- Vaquero equipment piece is still tethered. Will be released next week. This piece is designed for four seated students.

Conservation of Paper

- We are using 60 boxes of paper (10 reams per box) per month. Cost = about \$4000/month
- Need to examine our paper intake: worksheets, homework packets, etc.
- Third grade has made many copies of Go Math. Can the district provide student workbooks? Epps to research.

- Papers being sent home: some papers could be sent as email and parents could print (ex: optional STAAR packet, learning activities to-do-at home letter). Parents without email/printing capabilities could request/receive paper copy.
- Teachers can be conscientious sharing copies with team: send scans and pdf and teachers decide what they want to print.
- Tuesday Folder: have made efforts by not duplicating papers with siblings. Consider informational-only papers being sent via email as attachment. Handful of paper copies could be kept at Reception.

Student Uniforms

- The need for a more uniform and appropriate appearance for our student body.
- Counterpoint: Not having a uniform allows students to express themselves.
- We will start with establishing guidelines for appropriate clothing. If students come to school out of compliance, will be sent to Nurse's office to get appropriate attire.
- Shirt suggestion: no spaghetti strap, no tank top, no halter top, no midriffs
- Shoes suggestions: no Crocs, no flip-flops
- Skirt/Dress/Shorts suggestion: must be no shorter than the length of fingertips at sides
- Headwear: No hats or hoodies in the building.
- Teachers will ask their teams for feedback.
