### • Final school budget:

### School Safety:

- We have good protocols and procedures in place
- Make sure all students are together when going to activities outside of the classroom (garden, etc.).
- Continue to send students in pairs to restrooms or to run errands
- Keep your classroom doors locked
- Actively monitor during recess, spread out
- No former students may visit during school hours
- Report any security issues immediately to administration, school secretary AND plant operator
- Make sure exterior doors close completely when entering exiting the building

### • Committee Reporting – Suggestions for Upcoming School Year

- Consider looking at transitions in the hallway during lunch and ancillary time to avoid overcrowding; we will resume pre-COVID schedules for the 22-23 school year
- Consider backpack tags with teacher info and dismissal information; easily identify students if student is lost in the hallway and the student cannot communicate information.
- Consider Safety Patrol for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade in the fall semester and add 3<sup>rd</sup> grade in the spring semester (teacher recommendation, grades, and behavior, etc.). Have runners for morning and after duty and open car doors
- Address the field and drainage issue
- Request PTO to investigate updated park guidelines signage
- Car rider in the classroom-trash left behind in classrooms; things are broken; consider hallway and sit in number groups
- 4<sup>th</sup> grade requested storage for classroom materials new T-buildings do not have adequate storage
- Clubs: looking into reinstating after school clubs for next school year (name that book, math club, etc.).
- Email Ms. Epps additional considerations from the grade-level.
