- School Hours for 2018-2019: 7:30-2:50, 7:30-3:30 Magnet
- Parents will be allowed in the building for drop off from 7:15-7:30am only. All students arriving to school after the 7:30am tardy bell will need to be dropped off on the Stillbrook side of the school.
- There is NO PARKING on the SCHOOL SIDE of the street on Stillbrook & Atwell from 7am-9 am & 2pm-4pm
- Entrance Locations
 - Front of the school on Stillbrook
 - Willowbend Gate
- All cars using the carpool lanes MUST have a CAR TAG!
- 2:30 Dismissal for PreK ONLY until further notice
- 2:50 Dismissal Locations
 - Kinder through 1st Grade Stillbrook
 - If you have older students you may pick them all up at the Stillbrook side of the school.

- 3:30 Magnet Dismissal Location
 - Stillbrook ONLY

Step 5:

Once you are CLEARED to volunteer, you are eligible to volunteer in HISD schools.
