


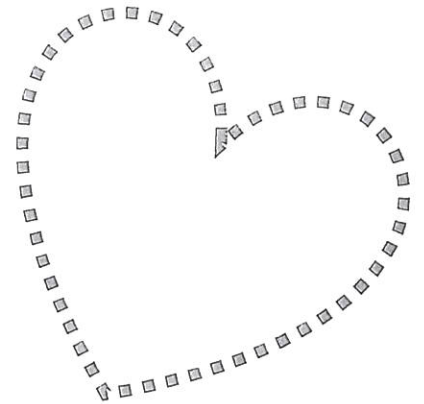
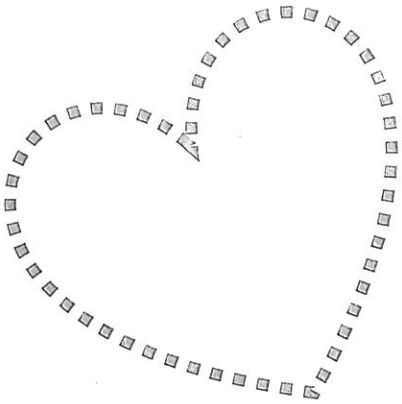

**Why:** To send your friends a special treat! Happy Valentine's Day!

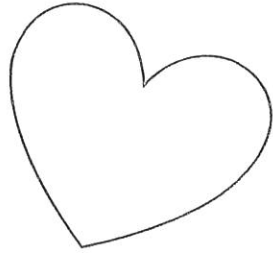
