Parker Advanced Chorus presents Kids Movie Night

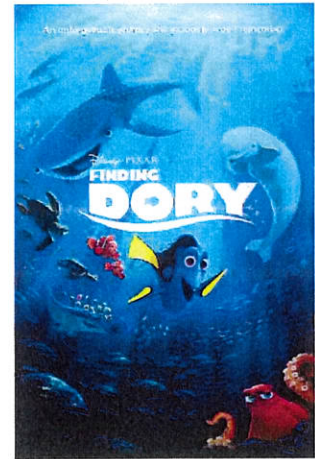
Movie: *Finding Dory*

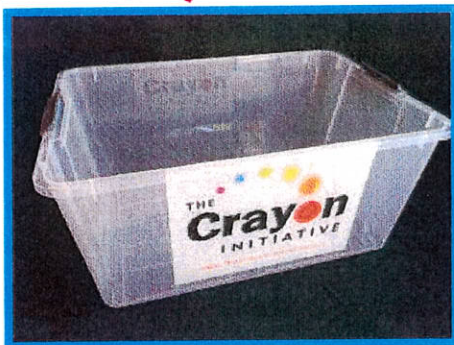
