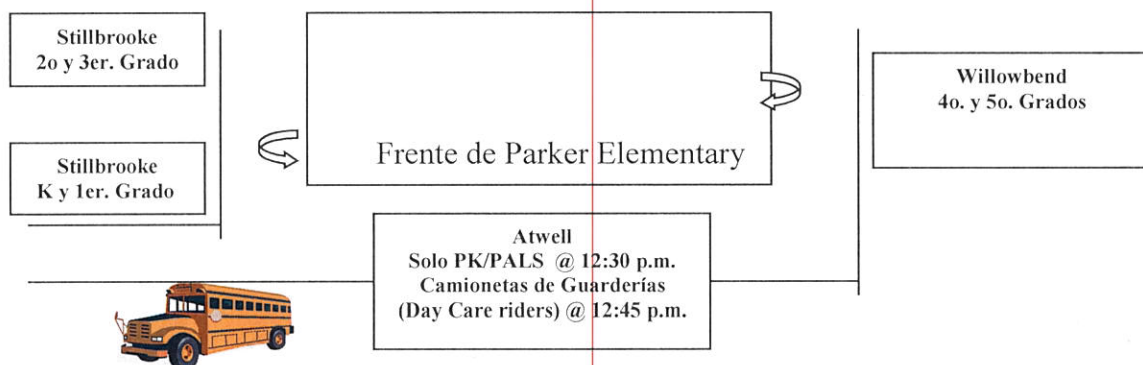

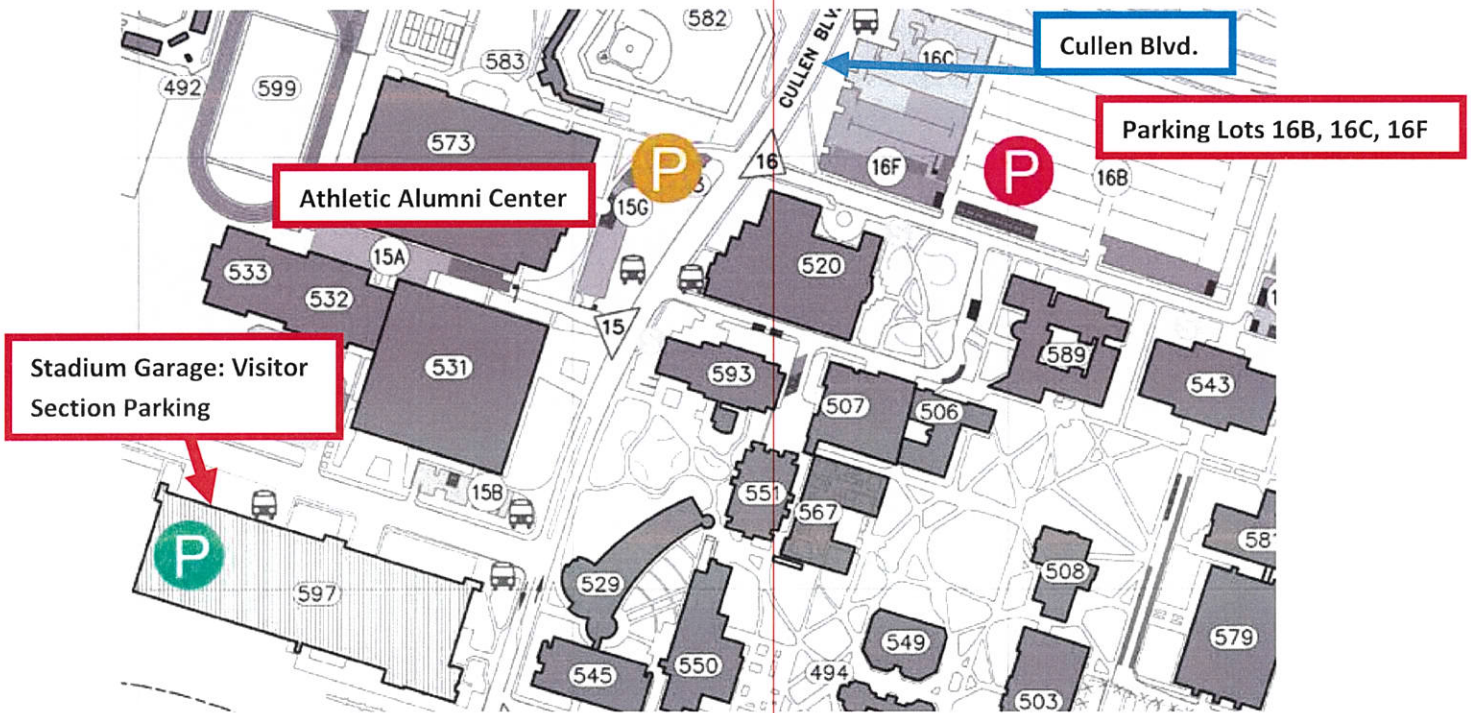

Parking is located in the following locations:

- All Flat Lying Areas and Parking Lots 16B, 16C, 16F (no fee to park)
 - Stadium Garage Weekend Visitor Section (fee to park: \$5)
- Metered Parking Rates: <http://www.uh.edu/af-auxiliary-services/parking/parking-on-campus/visitor/rates.php>

From I-45 South (Downtown)

- Take the Cullen Boulevard exit (Exit 44C) on I-45 South
- Turn right on Cullen Blvd.

To Parking Lots 16B & 16C:

- Take a LEFT into ENTRANCE 16 and park in the flat lying surface lot on the left.

To Stadium Garage Parking:

- Continue to Holman Street and take a RIGHT
- Travel to the end of the Stadium Garage on your left hand side.
- The Visitor's Entrance is the last one on the LEFT

From Clear Lake, Pasadena, and Hobby Airport:

- Take I-45 North to the Elgin-Lockwood exit (Exit 44A)
- turn left at the first light (Elgin)
- Go under all the bridges and take a left at Cullen

To Parking Lots 16B & 16C:

- Take a LEFT into ENTRANCE 16 and park in the flat lying surface lot on the left.

To Stadium Garage Parking:

- Continue to Holman Street and take a RIGHT
- Travel to the end of the Stadium Garage on your left hand side.
- The Visitor's Entrance is the last one on the LEFT
