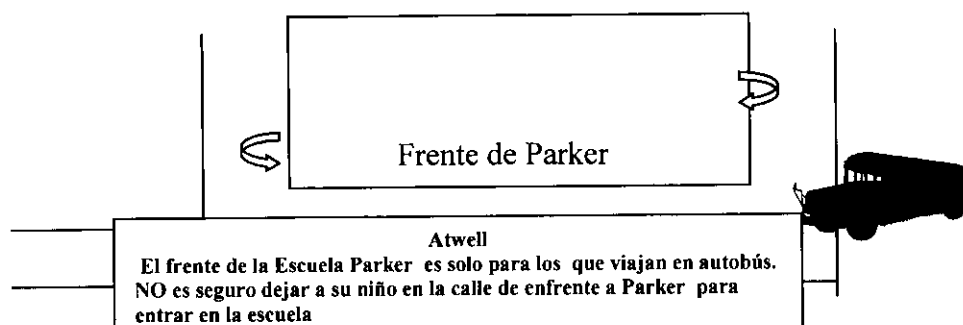

## Parker Elementary School Traffic Alert!

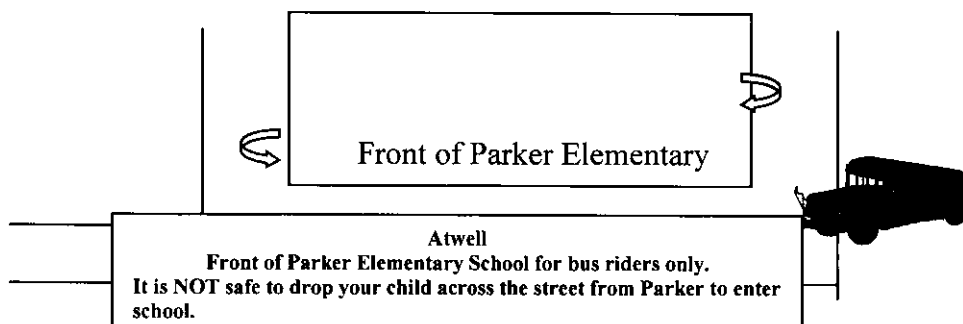

Please help us keep our children safe in morning and afternoon traffic.

- ◆ Safe drop-off /pick-up areas have been set up along the school side of both Stillbrooke and Willowbend. Do not ask your child to compete with this traffic. **Do not drop your child off across the street from Parker.**
- ◆ If your child is eating breakfast at Parker (7:30 a.m.-7:45 a.m.), drop him/her off along the school side of Stillbrooke or Willowbend. **Only bus riders are to be dropped off at the front of the school.**
- ◆ Wait patiently in the drop-off/pick-up area for both the carpool line and walk up line. Please help us keep all of our children safe.
- ◆ Please drop your child off on the school side of the street. Do not leave your child at Parker before 7:15 a.m.
- ◆ Please pick your child up promptly at dismissal time; **regular dismissal is 3:00 and Magnet dismissal is 3:40.**
- ◆ All parents picking up in the **carpool lanes MUST have a CAR TAG** with their child's name listed, please make sure you have one for any person who picks up your child.
- ◆ If you want your child to walk home alone (or leave campus alone) you must fill out a Consent form, please see your teacher or the front office for this form. **Students without the consent form on file will not be allowed to leave without an adult.**
- ◆ **Do not block residents' driveways OR FIRE HYDRANTS. Do not park or leave your car in the bus zone or in the drop-off /pick-up areas. This is a NO-PARKING/tow away area. All of these are violations and enforced by Houston Police Department.**

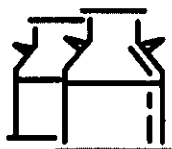

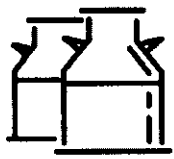

## Odyssey of the Mind: *The Team Sport That Isn't a Sport*

There are many ways for your child to be a part of a "team" outside of traditional team sports. One incredible example of this is a program called **Odyssey of the Mind (OotM)**. This international educational program allows students (Kindergarten through college) to work together in teams to creatively solve problems, including many STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) related objectives. These teams receive the opportunity to present their work at local, state, and international competitions.

"Odyssey of the Mind can give your children lifelong memories, experiences, and learning that will challenge them, allow them to have fun, and teach them self-reliance."

### Teams

Teams of students form in each school for the academic year. Each team consists of 5 to 7 members and 1 to 2 coaches. Teams select a problem and work on their solution over several months. They often work in a theme and present their 8-minute solution with a skit.

Everything is done by the students: ideas, decisions, script, costumes, sets, vehicles and contraptions.

### Odyssey of the Mind Problems

The problems are designed for competition, with scoring components and limitations, or rules to be followed. The long-term problems change every year. They fall into five general categories. These are Vehicle, Technical performance, Classics, Balsa wood structure, and Performance. Teams also practice to solve spontaneous problems. Students K to 2 present a non-competitive Primary problem.

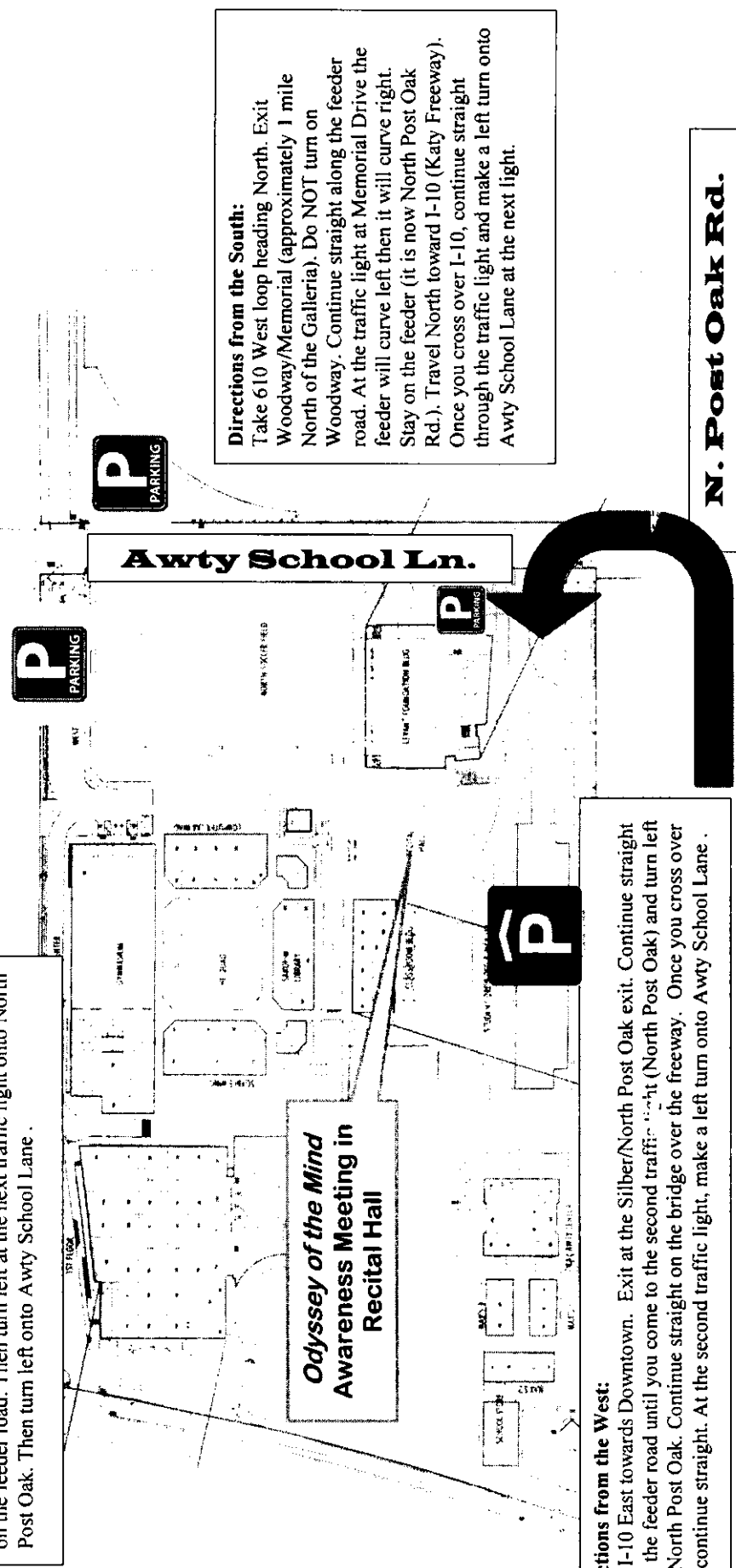

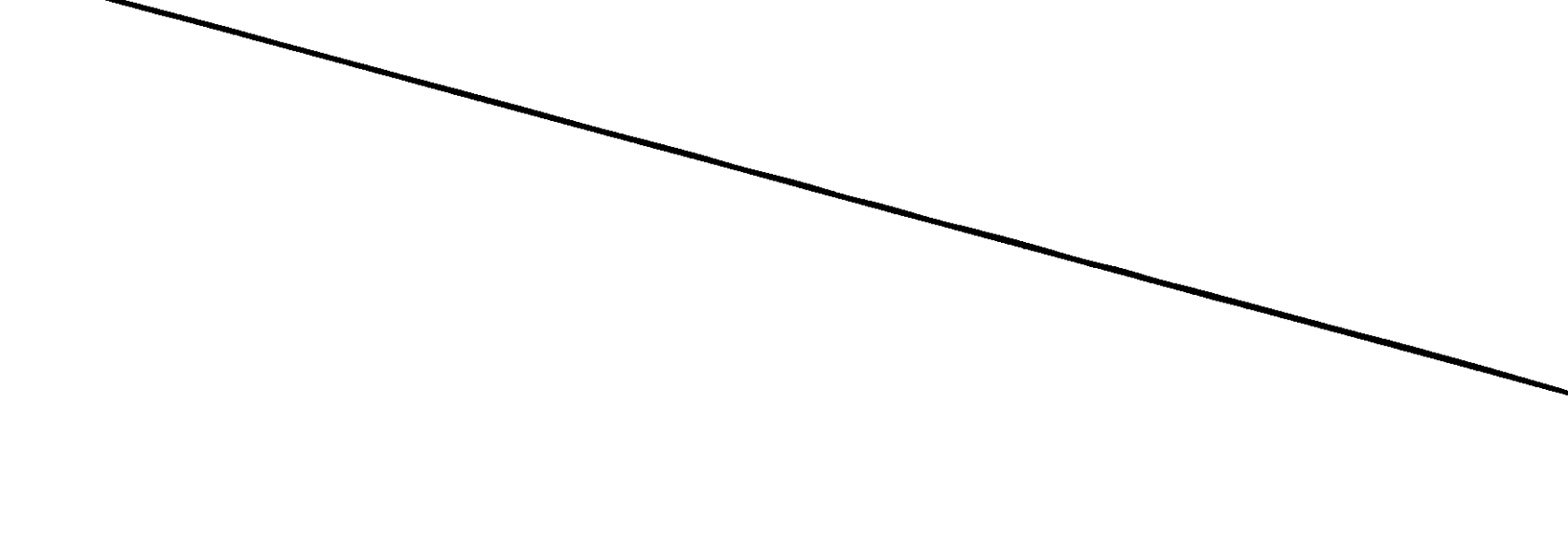

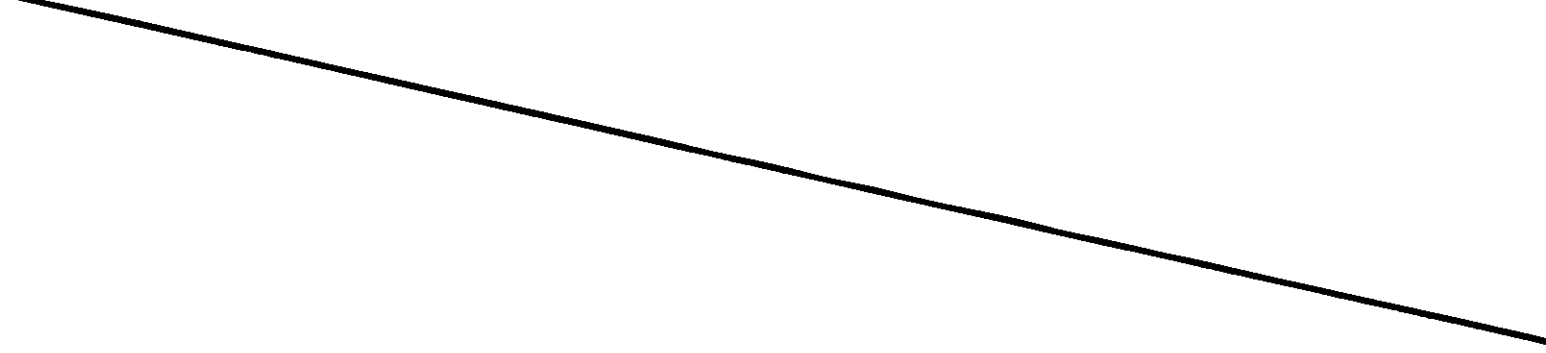
