

Parker Elementary will be moving into our NEW Building on December 22, 2017! Although we are very excited about this, there is a lot of work that has to be done and many school procedures will be changing as a result of moving into our new building. Please read through this bulletin and additional ones that will be sent for all the latest changes.

- Class Parties for the Fall semester will now be held on the afternoon of Friday, November 17th. This is so teachers and staff are given time to pack and get ready to move in December.
- Parker Library book check out will be suspended until January 2018, so that we have time to conduct a full inventory and get ready for the move. Please TURN IN all Parker Library books by November 10th. Students can access age-appropriate, HISD approved, online resources through the HUB by using the instructions below. Student accounts remain active until they depart HISD, and they are available 24/7 year-round.
 - 1. Log on to www.houstonisd.org/HUB your HISD login and password.
 - 2. Click on the "Digital Resources" tab at the top of the page.
 - 3. Click on the HPL Learning Link logo.
 - Enter your user name and pin in the following format: USER NAME: First initial of last name(capitalized)+ student ID number (e.g., Jane Smith ID#123456 will be entered S123456)
 - PIN: MMDD (date of birth) (e.g., 1201)
- Students will return for the Spring semester on Monday, January 8, 2018, and will report to the NEW Building. Please make sure any personal items are taken home before the winter break which begins on Thursday, December 21, 2017. Check Lost & Found prior to the break as well, items left will not be taken to the new building.
- Parent Open House for NEW Building/PTO Meeting will be held on Thursday, January 11, 2018. All parents will be invited to come tour the new building and join us for our first PTO meeting for 2018.



- Parking and outdoor space will be very limited beginning in January 2018. The
 entire construction project will not be completed until May 2018, so recess will be
 relocated to the park for the Spring semester. There will be NO on site STAFF
 Parking Lot so we are encouraging parents to use the carpool drop-off & pick-up
 beginning in January, rather than taking up the limited street parking that
 teachers will need to have available to them.
- Beginning in January 2018, there will be new entrance and dismissal procedures, these may change as we determine any necessary adjustments to ensure safety of all students.
 - Entrance Locations
 - Front of the school (which will now be located on Stillbrook)
 - Willowbend Gate (which will be located west of its current location).
 - 3:05 Dismissal Locations
 - Pre-K through 2nd Grade Stillbrook (one location only in front of school)
 - 3rd-5th Grade Willowbend
 - Magnet Dismissal Location
 - Willowbend ONLY
