Carpool Reminders:

- Dismissal is not until 3:15pm from K-5. Cars parked/waiting in the middle of the street will be required to circle the block, per HPD.
- Please follow ALL TRAFFIC Signs/laws: NO U-Turns, NO blocking crosswalks or driveways. This is being enforced by Houston Police Department.
- All parents picking up in the carpool lanes MUST have a CAR TAG with their child's name listed, please make sure you have one for any person who picks up your child.
- If you want your child to walk home alone (or leave campus alone) YOU MUST have a WALKER TAG, forms can be picked up in the office. Students without this form on file will not be allowed to leave without an adult.

Move Information:

- School in the NEW Parker will begin on Monday, March 19th, 2018.
- Please make sure any personal items are taken home no later than Friday, March 9th. Check Lost & Found prior to the break as well, items left will not be taken to the new building.
- Parking and outdoor space will be very limited beginning March 19th, 2018. We are asking parents to use the carpool drop-off & pick-up beginning March 19th, rather than taking up the limited street parking.
- Parent/Community Tours will be held on Thursday, March 22nd at 4:30 & 5:30pm.

Monday, March 19th:

- Students will be escorted to the following location in the morning for teacher pick up to classrooms (NO parents will be allowed into the building)
 - o Prek-1st Grade Cafeteria
 - o 2nd-3rd Grade Gym
 - o 4th-5th Grade Auditorium



 Parents MUST use carpool lanes for drop off or walk to school, please save street parking for staff. Only exception to this is Pre-K parents may walk students to entrance areas.

March 19th - 23rd:


- All Students will be escorted to the cafeteria until 7:30 and then 1st-5th grade will be released to go to their classrooms.
