- 1. Community Relationships/Partnerships
 - Goldman discusses that he wants to boost staff morality. Such has starting "Food truck Fridays."
 - Goal is to possibly have the owners donate 10% of profit back to the school.
- 2. Parent and/or Student Feedback
 - Primary feedback from parents is lunch
 - Mentioned bringing back free seating during the lunch periods
 - The new method of sitting arrangements during lunch has created a change for students to create new bonds
- **3.** Principal's Report
 - Staff attendance rate (88% 2023-2024) (91% 2024-2025)
 - Student attendance rate (93% last year, 96% has of the month of August 2024)
 - Mentioned the importance of Socioeconomic forms. The importance of these forms determines the grading level for our campus (283 missing forms)
 - Must meet IRT scores (instructional observations)
- 4. School Organization
 - Fernandez explains the changes that have occurred this year such as an attendance meeting once a week.
 - System created where parents are informed of their student absences
 - Goldman mentioned skipping was a major issue last year. This year he has created an attendance contract that holds the students accountable for their attendance.
- 5. Instructional Report
 - 10/10 rule (no students in the hall the first 10 minutes and the last 10 minutes)
 - Tardy stations on every hall
- 6. Magnet/GT/Title I Report
 - Testing all GT students this week
- 7. Counselor Report
 - Counselor are starting a new initiative "Lunch Bunch"

- If a student gets suspended, they must have a counselor session signed before returning to class. After three or more sessions the disciple will be more severe.
- 8. Grade Level Report
 - Down 98% on tardies
- 9. Staff Concerns/Questions
 - "Which campus would we be compared to if we boost our campus ratings?" Answer: We could possibly be compared to Lamar High School.
 - "Is there a deadline for all Socioeconomic forms to be turned in." Answer: The last week in October 2024
