Benefitting: Helms Elementary PTA. Helms is a dual-language (Spanish-English) immersion elementary school in HISD.

Purpose: Proceeds support the Helms PTA for the 2015-2016 school year, and new Hispanic Art and Culture ancillary programming that introduces students to countries, cultures, and concepts that are part of the Spanish-speaking world, and complements our Spanish/English Dual Language Magnet Program. Students will explore the history and geography of Spanish-speaking countries through music, art, and core learning opportunities. Helms is one of only two Spanish/English dual-language immersion elementary campuses in HISD, and our students are bilingual, bi-literate, and multicultural when they complete 5th grade. Helms is a Title I school, providing free breakfast and lunch for all students; approximately 75% of our students are economically disadvantaged, and over 40% are English Language Learners.
