Essential Question:

What are the roles and responsibilities of first responders?

The student will / can...

- 3. Identify jurisdictional problems that may arise as multiple agencies work together.*
- 4. Differentiate the roles of private security and public law enforcement agencies.*

Activities:

04/07/15

List "Police," "Fire," and "Emergency Medical Services (EMS)" on the board, and have students brainstorm the duties and responsibilities of each category. This exercise is to assess the knowledge students have about the roles and responsibilities of each. Once the students have taken 5-10 minutes to brainstorm, review the list. Add the actual roles and responsibilities of each to the list as needed. Use the Discussion Rubric for assessment. Also take notes over Unit VII Interagency Partnership for a quiz on Thursday.

Police Scenarios – Divide the students into groups and provide each group with a scenario. Have the students discuss which agency would be responsible for responding and how they would resolve the situation. A captain may be designated for each group to present the collaborative resolution. Use the Presentation Rubric for assessment. Also take a quiz over Unit VII Interagency Partnership.
