Essential Question:

Activities:

*Research A Crisis: Research a crisis such as a natural disaster or man-made*  
*Divide the students into four groups. Have the groups research natural or man-made*  
*disasters. Have each group discuss the disaster and what the procedures*  
*are at school. Have groups work together to create a plan of action.*  
*Use the Individual Work Rubric for assessment.*

*Use the following questions for class discussion. What is the mission of the fire service? Is there anyone in the class who is related to or has met a firefighter? What are some examples of other fire service jobs besides firefighter? Use the Discussion Rubric for assessment.*

*Have students research the career pathways in the fire service. This can be done with a web search or by contacting local fire protection service employers for information. Then have students create computer-based presentations of the results. Use the Presentation Rubric for assessment.*
