

**Petersen Elementary  
SDMC Meeting  
Monday, March 25, 2019**

**MINUTES**

Principal Arredondo called the meeting to order at 3:18pm. She welcomed everyone back from convening from Spring Break. She introduced the newest member of the SDMC, Ms. Hickman, Special Education Resource Chair. Having Ms. Hickman on the committee will ensure that we are keeping all scholars in mind when we make critical decisions for Petersen. Principal Arredondo briefly went over the agenda items that will be discussed at the meeting. She began with providing all committee members with an up to date copy of the Snapshot and Mock STAAR results. She went over the data as it relates to Domain I with a current status according to the Mock STAAR Data of a D. She reminded everyone of the specific campus STAAR goals. We are currently at a “D” (please see chart) = DOMAIN I however, our goals are the following: 80% - Approaches; 60% - Meets; 40% - Masters = A – DOMAIN I. We are striving for an “A” with 4 Academic Distinctions (*Academic Achievement in Math; Academic Achievement in Science; Top 25 Percent: Comparative Academic Growth; Top 25 Percent: Comparative Closing the Gaps*).

Next, Principal Arredondo went over the April STAAR administration dates so that everyone could mark their calendars. She would like the lower grades to make posters and signs to encourage the fifth graders to do well on the STAAR, so we can have them around the school. Principal Arredondo presented the idea of a STAAR Pep Rally where each grade level would do a chant and the cheerleaders and dance team would perform. Mr. Rose said that he would reach out to a friend for a DJ. Also, Ms. Hall said that she would remind the other lower grade teachers about signage and posters.

After discussing the Pep Rally, Mrs. Sanchez shared with the committee that the parents want to organize at PTO and they really want all teachers to participate. The registration fee is \$5. The forms to sign up will be placed in the teachers’ lounge. The “Students at the Center” team was briefly discussed and how it will be rolled out next school year.

All teachers and staff members have received the letter of intent to return in their mailboxes. Open Transfer Period is April 1<sup>st</sup> until April 26<sup>th</sup>. Also, the application was attached to Staff Notes. Principal Arredondo shared that we only have two vacancies – bilingual teacher and SIR.
