Dr. Covarrubia welcomed the SDMC for a brief meeting to discuss the lower than expected enrollment at Cage Elementary and Project Chrysalis Middle School as well as the budgetary impact. He expressed his regret for bringing bad news to the committee but also reassured members that as reassignments occur that every effort will be made to minimize the disruption to academic instruction.

Positions Impacted: 1 Classroom Teacher

He told the SDMC the administrative team would be meeting with the faculty and staff members that would be impacted by the end of the week.

Dr. Covarrubia mentioned that due to the current budgetary constraints, the school will not be making any major purchases at this time. Purchases will be made for supplies only.

It was also mentioned that the dinner service for Cage Elementary and Project Chrysalis MS would begin on Monday, October 2, 2017 from 3:15-4:15. All persons age 1-18 are eligible to eat a free meal. Adult meals are sold for \$3.75.
