**Shared Decision Making Committee
Minutes for Meeting 2/15/2019**

Three meetings for the Cage/Chrysalis Shared Decision Making Committee were held on 2/15/2019 (7:30, 8:15 and 9:05). The members of the committee that were present were Dr. Covarrubia, Dr. Rodriguez, Ms. Esquivel, Ms. Padron, Ms. Ochoa-Hernandez, Ms. Rosales, Ms. Garcia, Ms. Guerra, Mr. De La Rosa, Mr. Stott, Mr. Demello, Ms. Freitag, Mr. Gallardo, Ms. Melliza, Ms. Garcia, Mr. Hill, Ms. Buechel, Ms. E. Barrera and Ms. D. Barrera.

Dr. Covarrubia welcomed all members of the Shared Decision Making Committee. He also thanked Ms. Nieto and Ms. Reyna for taking on more students this school year to keep our budget balanced.

M-TADS:

Dr. Covarrubia thanked the committee for their responses to the idea of implementing a modified evaluation system for teachers similar to PDAS/MPDAS. He indicated that the teaching staff was in favor of M-TADS. He explained that the District is currently working out the details and that an official decision will be made prior to the end of the school year.

District Calendar:

The District calendar for 2019-2020 was shared with the Shared Decision Making Committee.

Start Time for 2019-2020:

Dr. Covarrubia shared an email that he received from Superintendent Lathan approving the same start time for Cage and Chrysalis for the 2019-2020 school year. The start time for both campuses will be 7:30 a.m. Dr. Covarrubia asked members to submit ideas for a Chrysalis dismissal as It is always hectic when both schools are dismissed at the same time.

2019-2020 Budget:

Dr. Covarrubia gave the Cage and Chrysalis budget sheet to the committee members. He indicated that the District planned the budgets based on a \$210 reduction per student. He shared that Cage will have an estimated budget loss of \$126,630.00 and Chrysalis will have an estimated budget loss of \$67,410.00. He stated that he doesn't know where we might be able to cut as we have made cuts to personnel for the last several years and there is not much more that we can cut. He did share that there will only be one copier in the teacher workroom for next school year.
