



SDMC Minutes

- Budget
 - Enrollment – As of now, Janowski has 612 of the projected 625 enrolled students with enrollment plateauing. The realistic goal at the moment is to aim for 616 students. Because of the low enrollment the school may potentially have to pay back roughly \$40,000. However, last year's overflow *may* be able to cover it. As far as teacher movement/placements due to low numbers, the worst case scenario would be that classes will be split and teachers would be moved but still remain at Janowski. Again, worst case scenario.
 - Title 1 – Due to the low enrollment money will likely remain tight for the current school year. There is \$135,892.85 in Title 1 funds albeit super restricted do to stipulations controlling how money can be spent. CPS's/Tutorials/Intervention is all pulled from Title 1 funds. As well, \$10-15,000 will be used for substitutes alone.
 - Ms. Bazan stated that despite the budget setbacks we will still operate as we always have. STAAR grades will not be affected by the budget.
- Fall Festival
 - Ms. Vasquez asked if grade level teams could use the Activity Budget for prizes. Ms. Bazan will talk to respective grade levels about it but likely money will be taken from the Activity Fund. Ms. Bazan will print out every grade level Activity Fund budget to see where they stand.
 - Ms. Espinoza asked when purchasing items for the festival if we should have the school order for us or provide receipts to the school from self-purchases. Ms. Bazan explained that most likely the school would use the Pro Card for purchases, however, if teachers *do* purchase things they must be tax exempt if they are online purchases.
 - The Festival schedule/map layout will be created next week as it pertains to station set up for grade levels.
 - Movies – Teachers can show movies during set up (day of) but must have permission to show PG movies. There will possibly be a streaming movie via announcements for viewing also. Parents are encouraged to help volunteer.

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- Safety and Security
 - Mulch – There is new mulch installed in the playgrounds for students' safety. Please advise students to be mindful.
 - Restroom Behavior – There is a rising current of defacement and bullying happening in the restrooms. Teachers are to be extra vigilant with students and establish new restroom etiquette. Particularly, if there is a student who exemplifies negative peer interaction tendencies they should use the restroom alone.
- Questions and Concerns
 - \$50 Reimbursement – One Source is not cooperative with Janowski at the moment therefore expect to be patient for the processing of it. Nevertheless, the \$50 reimbursement for self-purchased supplies is still in play. This may be the last year of it however, as the school (NOT the district) is paying back the money.
 - Writing Samples – Upon submitting writing samples, teachers must now attach evidence of the process along with the final sheet. As well, teachers must now submit whole class writing samples but process examples only with the six samples to be hung up on the bulletin boards. Bulletin sheets due 21st and whole class by 31st. Furthermore, formatting should be the same for each grade levels (subject matter is up to each teachers).
