






Parent Zone Account Agreement

By applying for a "parent user account," you are certifying that you have legal custody over the students whose records you seek to review. In accordance with school district guidelines, both parents are entitled to access to their child's educational records absent a court order specifying that access to a student's records is limited to a single parent or guardian.

The Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) (20 U.S.C. §1232g; 34 CFR Part 99) is a federal law that protects the privacy of student education records and affords parents and students rights to inspect and review, to confirm accuracy of, and to restrict access to student educational records. This Federal law has been codified by the State of Texas under Education Code Chapter 26 - Parental Rights and Responsibilities. 


