- Instruction grades due by May 22. Give every student opportunity to grow.
 Teachers want to grade assignment. Want to show impact we had on students. Data shows students are growing.
- End of Year June 1, 2020 for students- What would we be doing at Moreno? We would be celebrating. This day needs to be a celebration of the year for the kids. It needs to be a memorable day. Each team decides what this day will look like for the students. Ideas: memory book, game, cookies and juice.
- What will students that are not in SUMMER school do over the summer- What can students be doing over the summer month M-Th. Give different activities- include interactive activities. Examples: family fun, field trips, workbooks (we want to send all workbooks- this is a great time to purge). 3rd/4th grade collaborate with Chavez and Gomez on writing during summer school. Maybe require 3rd grade to keep a journal- daily writing very important. OK to have something ready for Moreno to print on Thursday/Friday and have ready for distribution on pick-up day for kids.
- Intervention Program for Moreno for next year- Intervention is going to be paramount.
 - Summer school intervention- reading intervention program is being selected and teachers will get training on the selected program. Teacher training/prep day will be June 4.

What can we improve on in terms of intervention? We need to identify a program we will all get trained on implementing- including aides that will be working with the students. Ms. Chavez will get trained on the program we select. She will in turn provide the PD to the entire faculty and staff.

• Next year.... How will classroom /day, /instruction look like? We all want to stay tuned to what the superintendent is saying about this. HISD is a District of Innovation (DOI). This will require that the district state how the school year will look like. There are different calendars being proposed. Major points that are applicable to us: 1) start school year earlier- before the 3rd Monday of August. 2) actual instructional day-elementary school day 7:30-3:30. Team leads- submit name of 1 parent that could serve on the superintendent's committee. They are looking for parents who are innovative and positive about the situation we are in. DUE IMMEDIATLEY

- Kinder registration date- 1st week of June. Parents will be notified of times/dates.
- Two new staff members will swing by Moreno next week.
- June GPC- invite parents of students who may need data for retention.
- Technology pick-up will be available.
- Thursday and Friday- hotdog lunch for staff.
