

Theme: Where We Are In Time & Place – an inquiry into the orientation in place & time; personal histories; *homes & journeys*; the discoveries, explorations, & migrations of humankind; the relationships between & the interconnectedness of individuals & civilizations, from local & global perspectives.

Central Idea: Changes in communities occur over time.

Lines of Inquiry:

- The physical environment changes over time.
- Causes of migration.
- As time progresses, cultures adapt.

Key Concept questions to provide openings for discussion @ HOME:

Perspective: What are the points of view?

Why is it important to know how something happened and the order in which events happened? Why is it important to see it from different points of view?

Change: How is it changing?

How does the physical environment change? How do cultures adapt?

Causation: What it is/like it is?

How do the changes cause migration/movement?
