Using Hoopla on Student Laptops

Setup your Hoopla account first at *hoopladigital.com*

Click Get Started Today

Search for the Houston Public Library in the drop down list

Enter Your Library Card Number (see slide 4)

The **email address** will be used as your Username

Go back to *hoopladigital.com* to log in





Read Hoopla Books Online



Click **Browse**, select **eBooks** Click on the book you want

Click Borrow, then click Read

Swipe or click through the pages

To close the book, click the **Menu** icon then click **exit reader**

Using OverDrive on Student Laptops

Setup an OverDrive account first at overdrive.com

Click Signup in the top right corner

Choose Signup using library card

Search for Houston Public Library

Under the results for the **Houston Area Digital**

Media Catalog,

Using ComicPlus Online

No need to setup an account.

Just go to *library.comicsplusapp.com* and click **Sign In**

Type in **Houston Public Library** Your Library Card Number (see slide 4) Your PIN (see slide 4)



Search for comics either by **Browsing** different categories or with search terms.
