		<p>comfortable there because teachers don't meet their expectations; some students don't feel like they don't have support from teachers</p> <p><b>Reflections:</b> Frank is discouraged that teachers feel the school is secure, but he is encouraged that our physical plant operator takes care of graffiti in a timely manner. Coach Davis was surprised that students felt safer in the classrooms than the school itself and is encouraged students do feel there's a place they do feel safe.</p> <p><b>Interpretations:</b> Having teachers carry out known procedures, what is the level of concern for their safety and climate? What areas of the school do they not feel safe in? How can we celebrate the elements of safety we do well? We need a system to carry out discipline. Teachers still feel safety is a big problem at school, so what is not done well at the executive level since we know we have a problem.</p> <p><b>Decisions:</b> Students, parents, and administrators need to take the same survey since 34 teachers only reflects a small portion of teachers and staff.</p>
