## Topics discussed:

- Sam Houston received the official NES Designation. The campus will be an NES school for the 2024-2025 school year.
- Staffing- the principal will receive the intent survey results received by district to determine what positions are available for next year.
- Transfer Period- March 25- April 8 NES School transfers, April 8- April 25 for all other district transfers.
- Magnet Program- Sam Houston has a new magnet coordinator. So far, we have 13 students signed up for the magnet program. We will be entering the Phase 2 of recruitment. That will take place this Saturday for the 9<sup>th</sup> grade class in the medical program.
- Upcoming events- Prom will be May 11 at Star Shine Venue from 6:00pm-11:00pm.
  Graduation will be June 9<sup>th</sup> at NRG the official start time is 9:00am. We are still waiting for more detail information. Summer School will be held at Sam Houston High School starting June 17<sup>th</sup> -July 19<sup>th</sup>. This campus will be a designated summer school campus. Hours of operation will be Mon-Fri from 8:00am-2:45pm for students. However, the building will be open until 5:00pm.
- Concerns mentioned- Community member Jessica Fuentas expressed her concern about students walking across the street to the school in front of cars. She wanted to know has the school investigated possible solutions to ensure the safety of students getting out of cars and walking across the street to the school. Mr. Solis answered that the school police have been working with HPD, in efforts to try to find a safety solution for everybody. Currently there has not been a remedy for this concern, but there have been discussions about possible solutions.
