



Summer Institute

The Summer Institute is a three-day program for preservice STEM4ALL students enrolled in the UHCLTeach program and Inservice teachers. The program also will support Inservice teachers in the surrounding partnering districts.

The STEM4ALL institute will be grounded in culturally pedagogical theories. Workshops will focus on incorporating Civic Science embedded in the 5E model from the Children's Environmental Literacy Foundation, Universal Design for Learning and ESL support.

- Day 1- Civic Science and Culturally Responsive Teaching Pedagogy
- Day 2 Civic Science and Sheltered Instruction Strategies and ESL Instructional Support
- Day 3 Civic Science and Universal Design for Learning
