Immunizations:

Students entering Texas schools require immunizations prior to first-day attendance.

7 th and 8 th grade students require a current Tdap and a meningococcal vaccine.

HPV is also recommended but not a current requirement.

Medication: An HISD order form must be signed by the physician and the parent before any medication may be given.

This form must be renewed at the beginning of each school year.

All medication must be provided to the nurse in the original pharmacy container to include demographic information and instructions.

Chronic Health Conditions: The health conditions listed require additional forms from your child's primary care physician.

Asthma, Seizure Disorder, Diabetes, and Severe Life-Threatening Food Allergies. Emergency Medication for the above conditions must also be provided to the school clinic.

Screenings: 7th grade girls and 8th grade boys will undergo screening for abnormal spinal curvature.

If you do not want your student screened, please provide the clinic with one of the following documents:

- 1. Document from a licensed professional that the student is actively under treatment for spinal curvature issues.
- 2. A signed form from the parent stating that this screen has been done or will be done during the current school year.
- 3. A signed form from the parent stating that this screen conflicts with their religious beliefs.

Screenings: All 7th grade students will be screened for vision and hearing.

7 th grade students will also have a Type 2 Diabetes Risk Assessment.

Any student that does not pass these screenings will be referred to their healthcare provider for further testing and treatment if needed.,
