We would like to remind parents and students that BCMA at James D. Ryan has a standardized dress code that the students are expected to follow daily. This dress code is designed to foster a sense of unity and pride in our school community. Students are expected to wear outerwear the same color as their designated grade level color (6th grade—gray, 7th grade—navy blue, 8th grade—burgundy). Students are not allowed to wear hoodies. Female students are not allowed to wear tights as pants. All uniform articles are to be maintained and worn to represent the individual students and the school positively.

On Fridays, students may wear jeans (they must not be ripped, frayed, or torn) and a school polo or school T-shirt only (college t-shirts may be worn).

Students must have a clear or mesh backpack Only!

The clear or mesh backpack rule is in place for safety and security reasons. It allows us to see the backpack's contents and ensure prohibited items are <u>not</u> brought to the campus. Another backpack will not be permitted, and students will be asked to leave them in the office until the end of the day.
