SC9000 Annual Survey of Children in Local Residential Facilities for Neglected/Delinquent

Type of Facility

The facility definitions below are based on the definitions from the ESEA statutes amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). This allows Houston ISD, the Texas Education Agency (TEA), and the United States Department of Education (USDE) to accurately determine your facility status based on the statutory definitions.

Local institutions for neglected children (section 1432(4)(A) of the Title I statute)

A **neglected facility** is a public or private residential facility, other than a foster home, that is operated for the care of children who have been committed to the institution or voluntarily placed in the institution under applicable State law, due to abandonment, neglect, or death of parents or guardians.

Local institutions for delinquent children (section 1432(4)(B) of the Title I statute)

A **delinquent facility** is a public or private residential facility for the care of children who have been adjudicated to be delinquent or in need of supervision.

Please note that TEA and USDE uses the facility counts based on the type of facility chosen to generate Title I, Part A funding (Neglected facilities) or Title I, Part D, Subpart 2 (Delinquent facilities).
