# SAT Scores

## SAT Score Reports Now Available!

Dear Parents & Guardians,

SAT score reports for your student are now available! Students can view their scores by logging into their **College Board account**.

## Why SAT Scores Matter

SAT scores are used by colleges and universities to assess a student's readiness for college-level coursework. The SAT also helps identify areas where students are excelling or may need additional support.

The College Board has established **College Readiness Benchmarks** that indicate whether a student is on track for success in college:

- **480 in Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (ERW)**

### 530 in Math

Students who meet or exceed these benchmarks are more likely to succeed in credit-bearing college courses without the need for remediation.

Encourage your student to review their scores carefully and use this information to help plan for the future—whether that means additional practice, retaking the SAT, or exploring college options.



As we approach the culmination of your student's high school journey, we are excited to share details about the upcoming Spring 2025 Graduation Ceremony. This milestone marks a moment of pride, accomplishment, and celebration—not just for our graduates, but for the families, educators, and supporters who have guided them along the way.

To ensure a smooth and dignified ceremony, we ask for your support in adhering to the established district guidelines regarding check-in procedures, dress codes, guest expectations, and security protocols. These policies are designated to maintain a respectful and safe environment where each graduate can be honored appropriately.

#### Graduation Details:

- **Date:** Saturday, June 7, 2025
- **Venue:** NRG Stadium
- **Venue Address:** 1 NRG Park, Houston, TX 77054
- **Time:** 6:00 pm

#### Graduation Requirements and Procedures

#### Student Requirements

Only students who have fully met all academic obligations will be eligible to walk in the graduation ceremony. To participate in the spring commencement ceremony, students must:

- Successfully complete all required credits and meet all state requirements by the last day of school, June 4th.
- No coursework, Individual Graduation Committee (IGC) assignments, or attendance appeals will be accepted after this date.

#### Check-in Procedures

- Graduates must arrive one hour before the ceremony for check-in.
- Upon arrival, graduates will be required to pass through weapon detectors or undergo screening with security wands.
- School representatives will guide graduates to line up and proceed to their designated seats.

#### Dress Code Requirements

- Caps and gowns are mandatory for entry into the ceremony.
- Appropriate attire must be worn under academic regalia.
- Modest heels are recommended, as graduates will navigate steps and ramps.

#### Approved Accessories:

Graduates may wear the following accessories:

- Academic medals and athletic achievement earned in high school.
- Honor cords representing academic excellence, clubs, or honor societies.
- HISD ribbons awarded for specific accomplishments.
- Graduation stoles approved by the campus principal or designee.
- Decorated or personalized graduation caps with prior approval from the principal or designee.

#### Additional Information

- **Electronic devices, including cell phones, are not permitted on the venue floor.**
- For cap and gown orders, please contact your campus graduation representative.
- Students are responsible for obtaining their own graduation announcements.

#### Guest Information

#### Tickets, Seating, and Parking

- Attendance is limited, and all guests (ages 3 and up) must have a ticket at Delmar and Barnett venues. Children must be seated with a responsible adult.
- Graduates do not need a ticket to enter through the designated graduate entrance.
- Seating is determined by each venue's capacity. Specific ticketing information will be provided by your campus.

#### Parking Information

- **NRG Stadium:** Parking is \$25.00 plus tax, and payment must be made via debit or credit card only. No cash accepted.
  - Guests attending at NRG should enter Gate 9 on Kirby Drive. HISD Police and parking attendants will direct traffic.
- **Barnett and Delmar Fieldhouse:** Parking is free at these venues.

HISD Police and additional law enforcement will be on-site to assist with traffic flow and directions.

#### Live Streaming

HISD will not provide a virtual viewing option for the graduation ceremonies. However, recorded ceremonies will be available for later viewing on the HISD Spring 2025 Graduation website:

#### Safety And Security

- HISD Police and additional law enforcement will be present for security and traffic control.
- First aid stations will be available on-site for any medical needs.

#### Bag Policy and Screening Measures

- All guests will be required to pass through weapon detectors and/or be screened with security wands.
- To expedite entry, guests are encouraged not to bring bags. If a bag is necessary, the following are permitted:
  - A clear bag (maximum size: 12" x 6" x 12"), or
  - A small clutch (maximum size: 4.5" x 6.5")
- All bags are subject to search upon entry.

#### Prohibited Items

Bringing prohibited items or engaging in inappropriate behavior may result in denied entry or removal from the venue. The following are not allowed:

- Disorderly conduct
- Smoking or vaping
- Alcohol or drugs
- Firearms, explosives, or weapons
- Laser pointers, drones
- Littering or use of glitter
- Noisemakers (e.g., air horns, cowbells, whistles)
- Flowers, bouquets, balloons, signs, banners, flags, beach balls, confetti, or streamers
- Any item obstructing another guest's view
- Outside food and drinks (exception: clear water bottles as needed for health reasons)
- Wandering into restricted areas
- Any item deemed inappropriate by Houston ISD staff

#### Behavioral Standards

#### ❖ For Graduates

Graduation is a formal occasion that marks a significant milestone. Maintaining discipline and decorum ensures a meaningful celebration for all graduates and their families. Graduates are expected to conduct themselves with dignity and respect throughout the ceremony, including:

- During assembly and line-up
- Throughout the processional and recessional
- While crossing the stage to receive their diploma

To maintain the integrity of the ceremony, the following behaviors are strictly prohibited:

- Poses, flips, dances, pranks, or hand gestures (except for a handshake while receiving the diploma).

We kindly ask all guests to support a respectful and orderly environment by following these guidelines:

- Silence all cell phones and refrain from phone conversations during the ceremony.
- Do not toss objects in the air, as this can cause disruption and safety hazards.
