DISCUSSION:

- 1. The Program Manager, Douglas Lacy, informed the PAT there are approximately six (6) potential bidders for Competitive Sealed Proposals for the new construction project for Sharpstown High School. Those General Contractors with interest are identified under Agenda Item "A" for reference.
- 2. The Program Manager informed the PAT the gas line relocation at the West Parking Lot although the relocation is complete. Center Point Energy failed to clean up the area where the gas line was

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- relocated and the sidewalk that had to be removed was not replaced. The Program Manager is currently coordinating with Center Point Energy to get the concrete walk in place...
- 3. The Program Manager informed the PAT there will be a site visit for potential bides of the new construction to review any existing conditions of concern prior to bidding. The site visit will be held on Wednesday, August 26, 2015 at 4:30 PM. The potential subcontractors are expected to be those with interest in asbestos abatement.
- 4. The Program Manager identified the tentative start of construction as October 2015 for the project. The potential building completion date shall be established within the proposed schedule from the successful CSP Contractor. The possible building completion may be February 2017 with site completion, potentially during the month of June 2017.
- 5. Michael Sabouni, Principle of the joint venture of Munoz/AUTOARCH, Architects, informed the PAT of the status of the Early Release Package permit drawings in review with the City of Houston. The permit for ERP #1 (Underground Utilities & Earthwork) was received on 24 July 2015. ERP #2 will be resubmitted for the second review the week of 31 August. No timeline has been identified of the approximate approval date.
- 6. Robert Myers, HISD Design Manager, informed the PAT of a potential agreement with the original designer of the Spark Park to enhance the current design. The agreement allows the participation of the original designer / artist to assist the Architectural Design team with further studies of Amphitheater Spark Park layout. Ideas shall be presented to the PAT for acceptance.
- 7. Proposed future PAT Meeting dates were accepted by the PAT.
- 8. Principal Gasparello requested the participation of the Design Team at the Sharpstown High School Open House set for 17 September 2015 @ 6:15 PM.
