DISCUSSION:

- 1. Principal Thuy Le-Thai welcomed the participants and introduced Mr. Clay Clayton of HISD and Mr. Spencer Wingate of Rice & Gardner Consultants.
- 2. Mr. Clayton confirmed with Ms. Le-Thuy that the 2007 Bond Program Scope of Work was completed in its entirety.
- 3. At the request of the PAT, Mr. Clayton played the 2012 HISD Bond video describing New Tech High in Coppell, TX to demonstrate some of the more flexible design aspects of a 21st Century School. The video can be found by accessing: http://hisdtv.org/new-tech-high-coppell/
- 4. Mr. Clayton wrote the PAT's list of objectives on poster paper and requested the PAT's assistance in prioritizing them. Each PAT member was asked to place markers adjacent to the objectives they felt were most important to final product of the project. The results of this exercise was the identification of following priorities from most important to lessor important:
 - 1. Small and large assembly/collaborative areas
 - 2. Secured entry/exit doors
 - 3. Apple/Google-like work spaces
 - 4. Courtyard enclosure
 - 5. Courtyard for dining/outside dining
 - 6. Operable partitions
 - 7. Moveable furniture
 - 8. More green spaces
 - 9. Security vestibule
 - 10. Flexible furniture/moveable tables and chairs
 - 11. Various types of seating
 - 12. Better lighting
 - 13. Day lighting
 - 14. Renovation of main entry
- 5. In response to a question, Mr. Clayton noted that proposed design firms have been interviewed by the Selection Committee which included some Sharpstown International PAT members. Final selection is expected by the HISD Board of Trustees shortly. Once under contract, the Architect will be invited to attend the PAT meetings.
