PURPOSE: The purpose of this meeting was to share construction progress updates and project design information.

AGENDA:

- Presentation of construction progress to date
- Discuss what to expect at the next Project Advisory Team (PAT) Meeting and if there should be a December PAT Meeting

DISCUSSION:

- 1. HISD Project Manager, Brian Alling thanked attendees for their participation in the project process.
- 2. Mr. Alling introduced Ms. Tammie Newman, Satterfield & Pontikes' Senior Project Manager Construction Manager at Risk (CMAR), who presented a slide show with photo examples of work recently completed and updated the group on ongoing work at Waltrip:
 - a. Athletic field restroom and storage building foundations have been prepared to receive concrete.
 - b. Baseball batting cage posts have been erected and the foundation has been prepared to receive concrete.
 - c. Some HVAC system chilled water pumps and pipe insulation have been installed.
 - d. The contractors have begun to remove portions of the existing exterior window system on the three-story academic wing.
 - e. Demolition and preparation for the new remodeling is continuing in the building.
- 3. Mr. Alling and Principal Schur presented the samples of the approved colors and materials for the upcoming renovation material finishes.



- 4. Principal Schur shared with the PAT information regarding the upcoming spring semester construction schedule. She presented the floor plan showing the existing Fine Arts (music, choir, drama) and option to either expedite demolition and remodeling of this existing Fine Arts area to begin spring semester of 2015 or an option to delay remodeling this area to begin in the fall semester of 2015. Delaying construction to next fall, offers an opportunity to minimize impact to the campus' use of the existing space. Expediting construction to begin earlier may be more disruptive to the campus operations, but offers the opportunity to show construction progress and campus use of a remodeled/new facility sooner. The PAT members commented they concurred with the Principal's preference to begin construction work sooner rather than later to show the community work progress as soon as possible.
- 5. Some PAT members voiced concern with the project budget and rumors they have heard in the community. They expressed their expectation that HISD will meet commitments made to the Waltrip community regarding the design scope for Waltrip High School. Mr. Alling confirmed the construction costs are higher than originally planned, and HISD is taking the project and campus needs very seriously and is working to find solutions to the cost issue.
- 6. PAT members requested that no building images be posted at the site and no Community Meetings be scheduled until HISD commits to the final building design and scope. The committee does not want to communicate wrong information to the Waltrip area citizens. Once HISD finalizes the budget and can confirm the final project scope, then a Community Meeting should be scheduled.
- 7. Mr. Alling and Principal Schur asked the PAT if they would prefer to skip the scheduled late December PAT meeting due to the holidays. Attendees agreed an update on the project construction and any other project updates could be emailed to them during the December holidays in lieu of holding a meeting.

ACTION ITEMS:

19-1 Brian Alling and Principal Schur will coordinate and issue an email in mid-December with project update information for PAT members in lieu of holding a December PAT meeting.

WHAT TO EXPECT AT THE NEXT PAT MEETING:

1. The CMAR will provide an update on construction progress at the next PAT meeting.
