**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this meeting was to share information of the project construction progress with the Project Advisory Team (PAT) members.

### AGENDA:

### DISCUSSION:

- 1. HISD Project Manager, Brian Alling thanked attendees for their participation in the project process and attending the meeting.
- 2. Mr. Alling introduced the Satterfield & Pontikes Construction team. Contractor project superintendent Wade Troxler presented a slide show of recent Waltrip High School construction progress.
  - a) Renovation of existing classrooms continues on all three floor levels in the central threestory classroom portion of Waltrip High School. Ceiling drywall, fire-sprinkler suppression system, electrical and plumbing work is continuing in these areas.
  - b) Exterior window replacement in the three-story classroom wing is almost complete with exception of the portion of windows near the school's front entry. This portion of windows are scheduled for replacement in the spring of 2016.
  - c) The boys' athletic locker room area renovation work continues and plumbing lines are almost complete and ready for inspection by the City of Houston. Construction of the new wall partitions will begin soon. Also, concrete floor trenches which had been created for the installation and rerouting of under floor sewer drain lines in this area have been filled in with concrete in preparation of new flooring.



d) The contractors have begun preparation for constructing the foundation of the new band hall and weight room additions. The new addition foundation piers are scheduled to begin drilling the week of November 2<sup>nd</sup>.

#### **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:**

- 29.01 Q. One of the PAT attendees asked when to expect the campus would need to move out of the existing band hall area. These attendees also asked when the gymnasium expansion construction was scheduled to begin and the campus not have use of this gym. It was noted there is a tournament scheduled for December 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> and the campus athletic department will need to use both gyms.
  - A. Both the gymnasium areas and the existing music band hall areas are expected to begin construction renovation activities after staff and students return from winter holiday break in January of 2016. The contractor did not believe there would be conflict for these dates but also cautioned the campus is a construction zone and access to the gyms is limited. The campus and hosts of the tournament need to evaluate for access availability for its visitors.
  - **29.02 Q.** One PAT member requested confirmation of estimated timeline when the courtyard brick pavers are scheduled to be installed in the front courtyard area.
    - A. The courtyard portion of scope is scheduled to occur during the summer of 2016.
  - **29.03 Q.** Another PAT member requested information on the timeline of current classrooms being renovated and if the teachers would be asked to move into their new classrooms the week of December 7<sup>th</sup> which is during campus testing period.
    - **A.** Mr. Troxler confirmed the move into the renovated classrooms would not occur until after testing was completed.
  - **29.04 Q.** Several PAT members asked if a Community Meeting presentation of the construction project status and communicate the scope for community citizens could be scheduled prior to the holiday break.
    - **A.** Mr. Alling indicated he would review this request with Principal Mitchell and HISD Bond Communications office for any conflicts with campus or district calendars.
  - **29.05 Q.** A PAT member inquired requesting additional information regarding the contractor contract.
    - A. Ms. Matisia Hollingsworth, HISD Bond office Senior Manager of Construction responded questions regarding contracts should be requested through an open records request to the district.

## WHAT TO EXPECT AT THE NEXT PAT MEETING:

1. The contractor will provide an update on construction progress at the next PAT meeting.
