REVIEW OF ORIGINAL BUILDING DESIGN:

- 1. FHHP reviewed the fault line location on the site and how it impacts the design and the schedule.
 - a. Neighborhoods F and G lay on the fault.

MODIFIED BUILDING PLANS:

- 2. All the program components remain in the building.
 - a. Neighborhood B becomes a 2-story, longer building.
 - i. Includes the academic portions of Neighborhoods A, G, and H.
 - ii. The clinic is included in Neighborhood B
 - iii. Child Care is moved from Neighborhood A to Neighborhood H
 - b. CTE from Neighborhood F moves to Neighborhood A.
 - c. Academic portions of Neighborhood A and B are switched.

DISCUSSION OF MODIFIED PLANS:

- 3. Neighborhood H to be closed for public events
 - a. Child Care to be on intercom system
 - b. Design is for 1,100 students (672 last semester)
 - c. Transportation will need to be informed about route
 - d. Connections for future PVC panels will be installed

ALUMNI HISTORICAL OBJECTS:

4. The Alumni committee is preparing a list of items to be displayed.



SCHEDULE:

- 5. Site work will begin in September.
 - a. Formal ground breaking will happen at the first of the year when the building construction begins.
 - b. With the redesign the fields need not be moved.
