Braeburn Elementary School to celebrate construction progress on new building

WHAT:

Braeburn Elementary School will host a celebration to recognize construction progress on their new school, which is slated to open in the summer of 2020.

Braeburn is one of four elementary schools being rebuilt after sustaining significant damages in August 2017 from Hurricane Harvey. The new school will feature open, brightly colored learning spaces, large windows with abundant natural light, and extended learning spaces throughout the building for individual and group collaboration.

Construction celebrations for the three additional schools being rebuilt — Kolter, Mitchell, and Scarborough elementary schools — will be held in coming weeks.

Media will be able to capture footage of the construction site, as well as students, staff, and district officials participating in the beam signing.
