Enrollment

- Pre-K is at 94.9% attendance.
- We currently have six waived classrooms with approximately 26 students school.

Curriculum and Accountability Ratings

- 33% of our student population has missed at least one day of school or more since the beginning of the school year.
- Mr. Gonzalez reviewed Domain 1 and how we earned a C rating in this domain. In Domain 2, we earned a B as a result of our data in reading/ELA. Mr. Gonzalez said fourth and fifth grade reading and math determines our overall success in Domain 2. In Domain 3, was a C. Our overall rating was B, with the help of Domain 2 since it is highest.
- Reading Achievement didn't show enough growth, and this includes SPED and subgroups.
- We earned two distinctions in reading and math
