



## Principal's Corner



Final exams for the fall semester are scheduled for next week. Final exams account for 10% of the semester average, with the three grading cycles equaling 30% each.

Students should report to campus based on the schedule listed below. Students will be dismissed from the second final exam each day at 12:40. Students will have the option to pick up a lunch as they leave for the day. Students should be picked up by 1:00 p.m. each day. Transportation will run in the mornings, but buses are not available for the 1:00 p.m. dismissal.

If your student is sick and cannot attend school for a final exam, make-up sessions are available. Please be advised, students will be initially awarded a zero for the exam grade. Once the exam is made-up, a grade will be awarded and the registrar's office will process a grade change. See the schedule before for exam make-up dates/times. If the exam is not made up within the designated three week window, the zero will remain.

# ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery) Program

Attention 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> graders interested in taking the ASVAB. The ASVAB will be administered at Lamar HS on Tuesday, January 25<sup>th</sup>. The ASVAB is a multiple choice assessment, administered by the United States Military Entrance Processing Command used to determine qualification for enlistment in the United States Armed Forces. This test covers eight general subjects, testing current knowledge and propensity to learn in different subject areas. It contains questions on English, science, mechanics and electronics. ### FAFSA STATE DEADLINE IS JANUARY 15TH

Has your financial situation changed?

Many FAFSA applicants have experienced recent financial changes due to the COVID-19 emergency or other reasons.

Has your (or your family's) financial situation changed from what is reflected on your federal income tax return? For example, you or a family member has lost a job or claimed [unemployment benefits](#). If so, you may be eligible to have your FAFSA form adjusted to qualify for additional aid. Follow these steps:

1. Complete the FAFSA questions as instructed (including using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool, if eligible).
2. Submit your FAFSA form.

3. Contact the financial aid office at the school you plan to attend to discuss how your financial situation has changed.

Financial aid offices can adjust your financial aid award to reflect your or your family's current income.
