Principal's Corner



A tremendous advantage of our current public school system is the opportunity for students to earn college credit while still in high school. This opportunity lessens the financial burden for families as students enter college.

Generally, schools will adopt one avenue for doing this and put resources into doing that well. Early College high schools partner with local community colleges to offer dual credit courses. Some schools use the College Board route and offer Advanced Placement (AP) courses. At Lamar, we invest our resources into building a strong International Baccalaureate Programme. IB Diploma level courses are available to all students at Lamar High School. We are the largest IB school in North America, and that takes a commitment to using resources to ensure our teachers are well trained and help students attain the skills and scores necessary to qualify for college credit.

At Lamar, we offer the full IB Diploma Programme (IBDP), with course work in all 6 academic areas. Students who commit to that work are accessing the most rigorous high school program available. A student who finishes and is awarded the IB Diploma earns the equivalent of one year of college credit at most universities. Students who participate in our IB Career-related Programme (IBCP) are enrolled in two or more IB Diploma classes. Those who finish the IBCP and are awarded the certificate will earn college credit for those individual courses and will also have earned an industry certification in the area of career study.

We also offer AP courses in the few areas in which IB courses are not available, for instance, U.S. Government. This allows students to maintain rigorous course options for all required courses. Lamar does not offer dual credit courses.

As students enter the spring semester of their 10th grade year, they will be asked to select either the IB Diploma Programme or the IB Career-related Programme for their junior and senior years. We have held meetings this week during the lunch period for 10th graders and will have our IB Diploma Coordinator join us tonight at the PTO General Meeting to provide an overview for parents.

Testing Updates

STAAR EOC Retesting Next Week– December 7-10, 2021

We will be conducting STAAR EOC (End of Course) retesting next week, December 7th – 10th. Students who previously failed an EOC or who were absent during testing last school year have been registered to take the required STAAR EOC exams. All identified students have received a reminder email this week with additional testing details. Students must pass all five STAAR EOC tests to meet graduation requirements. The next opportunity to retake these tests will be in April/May 2022. All STAAR EOC retests will be administered on the computer. Students must bring their fully charged laptop, charging cable, and headphones to their assigned testing room at 8:30 AM on the day listed below. The 2nd floor will only be for those who has purchased a ticket.



IB Fees Due April 15th, 2022

All students who are currently taking an IB course (SL2 or HL2) have been registered for testing.

The actual cost of registering students for courses is \$119 per subject. HISD and Lamar HS take on the majority of costs associated with the registration and administration of exams. Students are asked to cover part of the fee.

Whether you are taking one exam or are testing in 5 subjects, we ask that each student pay \$90 for the School year.

Students who complete the SocioEconomic form and qualify for additional benefits are asked to pay a reduced fee of \$30 for the school year.
