Finals Exemption Explanation

Student may gain eligibility for finals exemptions if they meet the following two conditions:

- Student may have no more than 3 absences in any one class.
- Student must have an E or S in conduct and no discipline referrals. Once a student is determined eligible for exemption(s) they will receive certificate(s) of exemption. They may submit to the teacher for any class with an 85 or better semester average.

Freshman – 1 exemption Sophmore/Juniors – up to 2 exemptions Seniors – up to 8 exemptions

Does TTM and Grad Lab count? Yes. TTM absences may be evaluated separately when a student is out for a full day.
