As we continue to improve the opportunities available at Lamar, we are identifying a few new opportunities for the 2019-2020 school year.

Practicuums - We will be looking for area businesses to partner with Lamar High School to provide real work opportunities for students. Some of those internships may be paid, while others are unpaid, but all allow students to get course credit and experience in their field of study.
