Arrivals and Dismissals

Driveway on Ernestine st. for 2nd thru 8th grade. Blue gates driveway.

If your child has a sibling in pk, kinder or 1st, then he/she must be dropped off and picked up in the Leeland St. driveway. Bus riders also exit through this driveway.

Safety is our number 1 priority. Help us with the following:

- Do not park on the street.
- Do not drop off in the street lanes.
- Be patient. Plan for traffic and slow lines the first week.
- Looking for police officers who can volunteer to direct traffic a few times a week.
- Do not hold up the line. Let your child out in the driveway.

Sports are sponsored by Coach Romero. They are from 3-4:30 pm, Tuesday-Friday




Fine Arts clubs offered by Cage teachers, are from 3-4 pm.

Freedom Dress Day for \$1

- **Once a month**, students have the opportunity to have themes days instead of their uniform.
- A calendar will be provided with the dates this takes place. The calendar includes the rules that students **MUST** follow.
- If students do not adhere by these rules, theme days will not happen in the Spring.

Fees and Field Trips

7th grade students have mandatory nonrefundable **activity fee** of \$80 that covers: Friday and STAAR WARS T-shirts, the winter field trip and the end of year party. This fee is due by September 30th, 2022.

An additional, optional fee of \$350 covers the visit to the Alamo and three university visits: UT in Austin, Sam Houston State and Texas A&M in College Station. The fee covers hotel stay, coach bus transportation, and all meals.

We have created an easy PAYMENT PLAN for the optional fee. The payment plan will be sent home the first week of September pending field trip approvals.

Uniform and dress code



Dress Code

- No ripped jeans allowed!
- No joggers.
- Skirts and shorts must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.
- Page 16 in the family handbook has a detailed list of dress code at Chrysalis.



Uniform

- BLUE Jeans or Khaki uniform slacks, shorts or skirts
- 6th grade: Navy blue polo shirt with collar and school logo
- 7th grade: Maroon polo shirt with collar and school logo
- 8th grade: Black polo shirt with collar and school logo
- Dark Gray Sweatshirt/Jacket with school logo.

5. I will always be responsible for my behavior, online and offline.
6. I will dress in proper school attire and wear my ID badge daily.
7. I will do my absolute best each day and strive to maintain a minimum of a B average in all my classes.
8. I will serve a minimum of **20** community service hours this school year and maintain an accurate record of these hours.
9. I will participate in all fundraisers to assist my school.
10. I will not disrespect anyone in any way on campus or on any school activities off campus.
11. I have read and understand that I will follow all school rules.

If I do not comply/obey all the above, I understand that I could/will be exited from Project Chrysalis Middle School.

Parent Contract

As parent(s) of Project Chrysalis student, I commit to actively participate in the educational success of my son/daughter. Therefore, I commit to the following:

- 1) **See that my child attends school every day, is punctual and always picked up on time.**
- 2) **Establish a place and time for homework.**
- 3) **Review my child's agenda daily, and sign it if necessary.**
- 4) **Review letters and documents sent home to me thoroughly.**
- 5) Create an account in **parent connect**.
- 6) Encourage my child to follow the PCMS Discipline System and Honor Code.
- 7) Seek assistance for my child if there is any problem in keeping him/her from doing well in school.
- 8) Support the school's choice of discipline and enforce discipline consequences at home in order to ensure that my child will maintain appropriate behavior towards teachers, staff, and students always.
- 9) I commit a minimum of **8** hours of volunteer service a school year and to participate in fundraisers the school sponsors.
- 10) I have read, understand and will comply with all the expectations as set forth in the school handbook and orientation.

Attendance

Your child must be at school by 7:30 am and be picked up at 3 pm.

Please do not drop students off before 7 am.

YOUR CHILD IS MARKED ABSENT NOT ONLY FOR THE DAY, BUT FOR EVERY CLASS HE/SHE MISSES.

Make doctor's and dentist's appointments after school whenever possible.

If your child is ill and needs to be picked up from school, school personnel will call you. Your child should let an adult know if he/she is sick for their safety. You should not receive a call from your child for you to come to pick them up.

Grading Policy

Re-Take Policy:

- Students will be allowed to re-take exams if the students received a **69 or lower** on the original exam.
- Students will **not** be allowed to re-take quizzes, final exams, end-of-cycle exams, or district benchmarks.
- The **student** must request to take the re-take within **five school days** of receiving the grade.
- The maximum grade earned on a **re-test** will be a **70**.
- Students will take an **alternate form** of the original exam.

Late Work Policy:

- Students will have until the **next class period** to submit any late assignments for the highest possible grade of a **70**.

Make Up Work Policy:

- In the case of excused absences, students will have a number of days **equal to that of their absence** to turn in make-up work **without penalty**. After this time has passed, the late work policy will be applicable.

6-week grading cycles

- Progress Reports go out to families after the third week of the cycle.
- Report cards go out to families after the last (sixth) week of the cycle

Cell phones and smartwatches Policy

- All electronics must be off during school hours.
- Do not text or call your child during school hours. If you need to contact your child, please call the school and we will deliver the message.
- If your child is going home due to illness, school staff will call you to pick up your child. Your child should not be calling or texting you during school hours unless school staff has given them permission.
 - First time violation: Confiscation and parent notification
 - Second time: Confiscation and \$15 fine
 - Third or more: Administrator discipline action

Discipline: Clipboard and AIM

CLIPBOARD

- Two sides to each clipboard: Respect and Responsibility
- Marks: students receive “marks” on each side when they do not demonstrate positive student behaviors.



3-MARK NOTICES:

Parents are notified with a form and phone call
 Form must be signed and returned the next day
 Detention is served on Fridays from 3- 4 pm
 After two detentions in the same grading cycle a child will automatically be placed on AIM



REFERRAL:

AIM Respect or Responsibility is assigned after 5 marks in the same week.


